**ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19**

**Introduction:**

After collecting and analyzing the feedback from students and faculty for the academic year 2018-19, the institution has undertaken several actions to address the areas of concern and improve the overall quality of the curriculum. This report highlights the actions taken based on the feedback received from stakeholders.

**Key Findings from Feedback:**

**Students' Feedback:**

83% of students agreed that the curriculum is aligned with the practical needs of the legal profession.

50% of students felt that the curriculum fosters innovative thinking, with 33% expressing uncertainty.

70% of students believed the curriculum includes current legal amendments for effective learning.

67% of students found the course outcomes well defined, while 27% showed uncertainty.

70% of students agreed that the syllabus is reviewed regularly to include the latest developments, but some expressed uncertainty.

**Faculty Feedback:**

100% of faculty agreed that the curriculum meets its objectives and emphasizes fundamental concepts.

75% of faculty agreed that the curriculum covers modern/advanced topics and aligns with current industry requirements.

75% agreed that the curriculum helps develop innovative thinking, with 25% suggesting there is room for improvement.

**Actions Taken Based on Feedback:**

**Enhancing Practical Application of Curriculum:**

**Action:** Workshops and seminars with legal professionals were introduced to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and practical application. Real-life case studies and moot court competitions were integrated more frequently into the course.

**Impact:** These measures were designed to provide students with hands-on experience and improve their understanding of how theoretical concepts are applied in real-world legal scenarios.

**Impact:** This process ensures that any changes or amendments in the legal field are swiftly incorporated into the teaching materials, providing students with the most up-to-date information.


**Faculty Development Programs:**
