

Feedback Analysis Report for AY 2020-21

Student Feedback on Curriculum

1. Curriculum is based on the practical needs of the legal profession:

- **Strongly Disagree:** 33 students (13.6%)
- **Disagree:** 40 students (16.5%)
- **Not Sure:** 35 students (14.4%)
- **Agree:** 65 students (26.7%)
- **Strongly Agree:** 70 students (28.8%)

A total of **55.5%** of students (135 out of 243) agree or strongly agree that the curriculum aligns with the practical needs of the legal profession. However, **44.5%** of students either disagree, are unsure, or strongly disagree, indicating the need for improvements in ensuring that the curriculum reflects practical legal skills.

2. Curriculum is effective in developing innovative thinking among students:

- **Strongly Disagree:** 40 students (16.5%)
- **Disagree:** 25 students (10.3%)
- **Not Sure:** 68 students (28%)
- **Agree:** 85 students (35%)

- **Strongly Agree:** 25 students (10.3%)

Only **45.3%** (110 students) agree or strongly agree that the curriculum fosters innovative thinking, while a significant **44.5%** are unsure or disagree. This indicates a substantial need to enhance the curriculum's capacity to encourage creativity and innovative thought.

3. Curriculum includes current amendments for effective learning:

- **Strongly Disagree:** 20 students (8.2%)
- **Disagree:** 30 students (12.3%)
- **Not Sure:** 15 students (6.2%)
- **Agree:** 94 students (38.7%)
- **Strongly Agree:** 84 students (34.6%)

A robust **73.3%** of students (178 out of 243) believe that the curriculum effectively incorporates current amendments, demonstrating a positive reception in this area. Still, **26.5%** remain neutral or express disagreement, suggesting room for improvement in how updates to legal amendments are communicated and integrated into the curriculum.

4. Course outcome is well defined:

- **Strongly Disagree:** 14 students (5.8%)
- **Disagree:** 15 students (6.2%)
- **Not Sure:** 85 students (35%)
- **Agree:** 75 students (30.9%)
- **Strongly Agree:** 54 students (22.2%)

While **53.1%** of students agree or strongly agree that the course outcomes are well defined, a notable **46.9%** are unsure or disagree, indicating a significant need for clearer communication of course objectives and expected outcomes.

5. The syllabus is reviewed at regular intervals to include the latest developments:

- **Strongly Disagree:** 27 students (11.1%)
- **Disagree:** 27 students (11.1%)
- **Not Sure:** 29 students (11.9%)
- **Agree:** 75 students (30.9%)
- **Strongly Agree:** 85 students (35%)

Approximately **65.9%** of students (160 out of 243) feel the syllabus is regularly updated to reflect the latest developments, but **34.1%** express either disagreement or uncertainty. This suggests a need for increased transparency about the review process and how new developments are incorporated into the syllabus.



Faculty Feedback on Curriculum

Scale:

- 1 = Strongly Agree
- 2 = Agree
- 3 = Neutral
- 4 = Disagree

1. The Curriculum Meets Its Objectives:

- **Agree (2):** 100% (All 14 faculty members)

All 14 faculty members unanimously agree that the curriculum meets its objectives, showing a strong consensus regarding the curriculum's clarity in fulfilling its educational goals.

2. The Curriculum Puts Emphasis on Fundamentals:

- **Agree (2):** 43% (6 out of 14 faculty members)
- **Neutral (3):** 57% (8 out of 14 faculty members)

While 43% of faculty agree that the curriculum emphasizes fundamental concepts, the remaining 57% remain neutral, suggesting there may be room for better clarification or reinforcement of core legal principles in the curriculum.

3. The Curriculum Covers Modern/Advanced Topics:

- **Agree (2):** 64% (9 out of 14 faculty members)
- **Neutral (3):** 36% (5 out of 14 faculty members)

The majority of faculty (64%) agree that the curriculum covers modern and advanced topics, but a sizable portion (36%) remains neutral, indicating that more contemporary or cutting-edge legal topics could be integrated to strengthen this aspect of the curriculum.

4. The Curriculum Meets the Current Industry Requirements:

- **Agree (2):** 71% (10 out of 14 faculty members)
- **Neutral (3):** 29% (4 out of 14 faculty members)

With 71% of faculty agreeing that the curriculum aligns with current industry standards, there is overall satisfaction with this aspect. However, the 29% neutral responses suggest a potential need for further alignment with the evolving demands of the legal industry.

5. The Curriculum is Effective in Developing Innovative Thinking:

- **Agree (2):** 71% (10 out of 14 faculty members)
- **Neutral (3):** 21% (3 out of 14 faculty members)
- **Disagree (4):** 7% (1 out of 14 faculty members)

Most faculty members (71%) agree that the curriculum encourages innovative thinking, although 21% are neutral and 7% disagree, indicating that there could be improvements made in encouraging more creative and innovative thought processes within the curriculum.

Summary

- **Student Feedback:** The majority of students feel positive about the curriculum's alignment with practical legal needs and its inclusion of current amendments, with 55.5% and 73.3% respectively agreeing. However, there are significant concerns about the curriculum's ability to foster innovative thinking, with 44.5% expressing uncertainty or disagreement, and many students seeking clearer course outcomes and syllabus updates.
